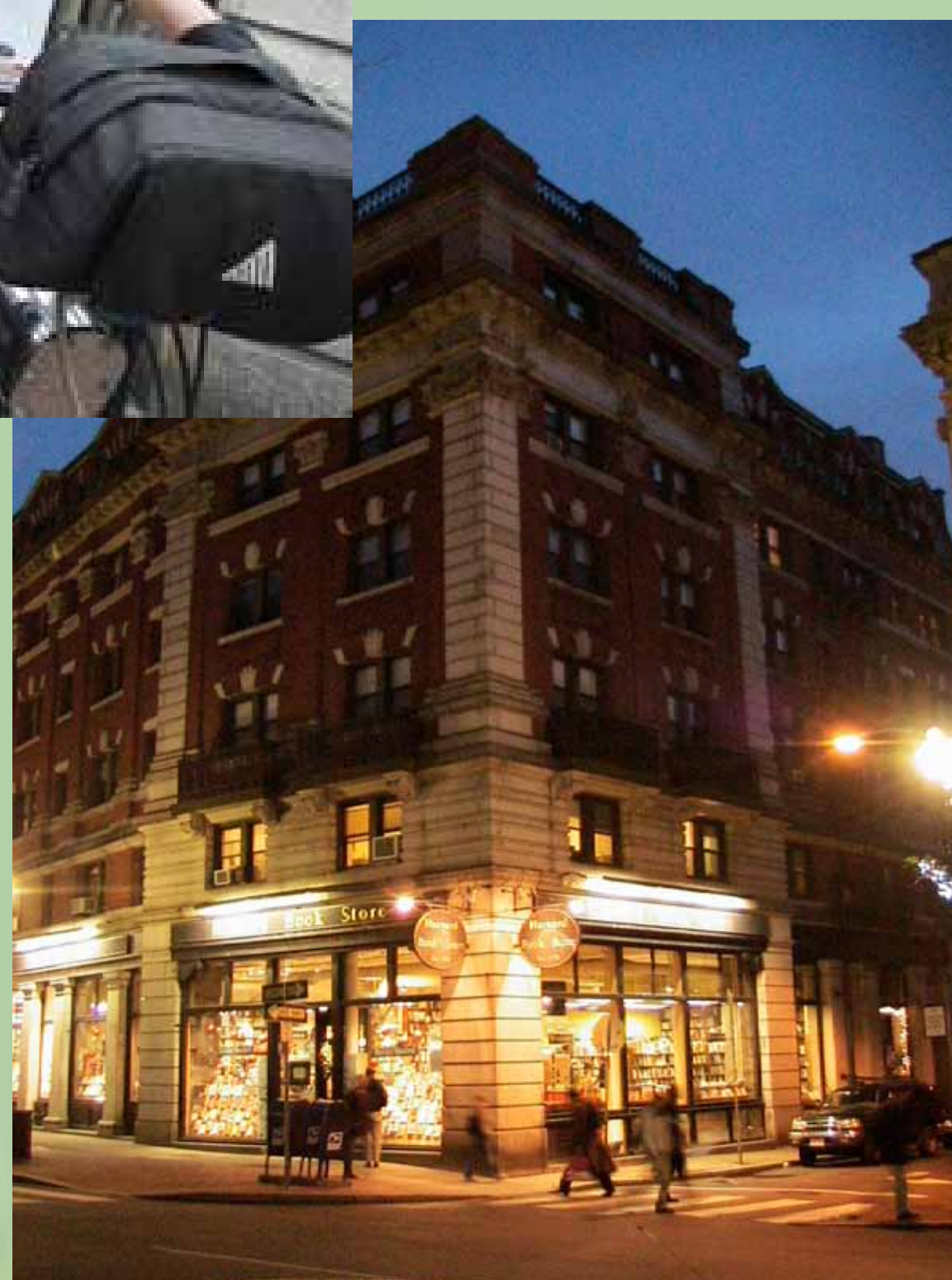
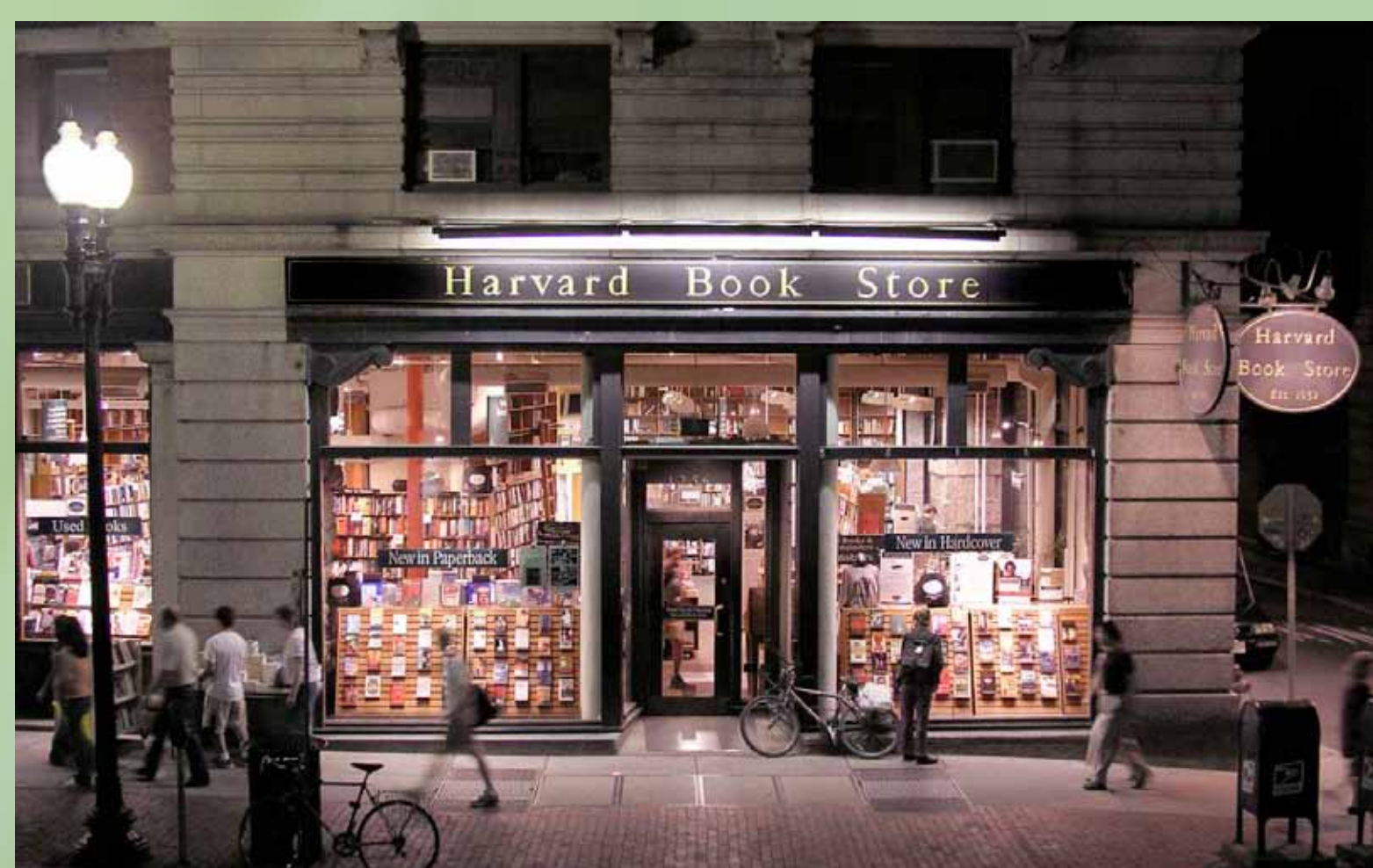
ACCOMPLISHMENTS
