### ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Offered free transit passes for one month to employees with a parking pass, so they could try transit. After the program, 79 employees switched to transit for their commute.
- Five bicycle repair stations have been installed and maintained in covered areas around campus.
- MIT offers commuting benefits such as a \$20 monthly bicycling subsidy, or 50% subsidy on monthly commuter rail passes for full time employees.
