
Dear Ms. Drury

WHEREAS: Over 700 people have signed a petition requesting that the INS allow Giovanni to stay in Cambridge; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record supporting Giovanni Hoyos-Corrales in his efforts to remain in Cambridge and urging the INS to find a resolution that enables Giovanni to continue his life as a valuable and valued member of the Cambridge community; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the U.S. Immigrations and Naturalization Service, Representative Capuano and Senator Kerry, Senator Kennedy and Giovanni Hoyos-Corrales on behalf of the entire City Council.






