My full time job provided us with affordable health insurance and I was able to help with my son's college tuition.

All that ended when Sanofi Genzyme hired ACM to clean in their buildings in Canton.

ACM did not offer me a job even when I explained I was there for 14 years.

I was an experienced and reliable employee and in October I lost my employment, our families healthcare.

The only thing I won was worry – how to pay for medicines, how to pay the bills, how to keep the house, how to help my son pay for college.

I was 1 of 56 workers that lost their jobs. Now Genzyme is going to do it again but to 150 workers.
