To all the Councilors I would like to comment on Councilor Kelly's policy order #1

The problem that Councilor Kelly is trying to fix at the Marino Center stems from a past developer Less Marino that was allowed to develop the Marino Center with off site parking. What happens if and when St Johns closes do the condo docks become void and unsellable. These problems all lead you back to our DEVELOPER FRIENDLY PLANNING BOARD OF OVER PAID PUPPETS.
