I write you from Geneva Switzerland, regretting to not be present at this important Council Meeting. Please consider my entire support in reuesting interdepartmental work with due consideration of all issues pertinent to the new proposed development on New St.

Safe pedestrian and non motorized traffic are as important as retaining the current xonfiguration of Danehy Park and its immediate surroundings, without any least sacrifice of public property. Proper automotive traffic managemebt must also be included that does not further congest the rotary or Concord Ave. - a true planning challenge.

I stand behind all similar initiatives regarding other developments, particularly in the Alewife/Fresh Pond/Huron areas, but also citywide.

If proper coordination between Coty Departments cannot be established promptly (within an acceptable timeframe, I.e. no longer than 3 months) to adequately reflect citizen concerns, I support a full moratorium on all development until an adequate Master Plan is established, which gives due consideration to citizen concerns both current and future.
