










5-FT COASTAL FLOOD FORECAST INCLUDING SEA LEVEL RISE (TOTAL RISK)*



*Figure based on selected sea level rise scenario. See Projections tab to left for more.




2010 Storm: Alewife Brook Parkway, Rt 16, ducks floating where street was. Alewife Brook was flooded into street for days




