Mr. Mayor, Mr. Vice-Mayor, and honorable members of the City Council:

The Whittemore Action Committee, a neighborhood group formed to preserve the Whittemore Ave Community Garden, is pleased to present to you this **Petition to Conserve and Restore the Whittemore Avenue Community Garden** in North Cambridge.

To date, we have collected **568 signatures** from Cambridge residents supporting this effort.

In the late 1970s, Magoun St. resident James Royster convinced Whittemore Ave. greenhouse owner Ed Norberg to let residents garden on a plot of disused land that had formerly been commercial flower beds. For over 30 years residents from across the City had a great place to garden and meet and chat with each other and the many people walking by, right by Linear Park and near the T.

The petition, much like the one in 2011, calls upon the City to acquire the Whittemore Ave Community Garden, which is one small parcel of the 3.8 acres being successfully redeveloped by Fawcett Oil. Across the street from the Garden, plans are approved for 75 units in total (57 in one building, the rest as duplexes), but the fate of the Garden is still uncertain. The petition goes further this time, requesting the use of the power of eminent domain if an amicable purchase cannot be realized. Here's why.

Early in 2011 a policy order from Mayor Henrietta Davis was approved to purchase the site. Fawcett was amenable; an appraisal was done and an acceptable price determined. Soil testing showed there was some arsenic which would need to be cleaned-up first. This delayed the process, and Fawcett backed away, forming new plans to raise capital for the big project by slicing off some lots across the street. The Garden site was then given to Rob Fawcett, Jr., son of the owner of Fawcett Oil, to be his personal project to monetize.

It may be the case that Mr. Fawcett, Jr. is willing to sell the site to the City, but all signs point to that not happening if we sit back and do nothing: He filed a subdivision plan in 2012; he has expressed in personal communication (Feb 2014) that he's not sure the neighborhood should have such an amenity given resistance presented to his larger project; and he expressed concern (May 2013) that he personally would be suffering a financial burden that his other family members would not be sharing if he sold land solely owned by him instead of developing it into 3 or 4 units of market-rate housing. On this last point, he and I concluded back then that the way forward involved him trading the Garden for some of the carved-out parcels across the street. However, that never occurred, and earlier this year three of the four parcels were sold together for \$1,500,000.

The petition tries to be optimistic, and starts with the premise that Fawcett and the City's attention is simply elsewhere, and hopes that reminding everyone of the benefits of preserving this Garden will be enough to restart negotiations. For the City, it fulfills published Open Space goals to add Community Garden plots (which were published before the loss of these 65 plots, 15% of the City's total), and there

are few opportunities to do that City-wide. An oversized Residence-B zoned plot has comparatively low development potential and thus value compared to most other locations in the City. It preserves a site which has historically only ever been used for agriculture. It acts as a natural heat sink and water storage in the Alewife Brook floodplain. It gives people without space of their own a place to grow flowers and their own food.

But most importantly, it is a focal point of the neighborhood. There is a lot of foot-traffic past the site, due to the proximity of an entrance to Linear Park (which thanks to the Planning Board and Fawcett will be upgraded soon). It's an active place, where people encounter each other and end up talking, even if they aren't gardeners. It will help draw people out of Fawcett's future large building and help us meet our new neighbors. And with the loss of the Deborah Mason School of Dance, our other community meeting spot, this is even more important to preserve.

It makes good neighborhood planning sense. We must be more than a collection of bedrooms. Planning Board Chairman Hugh Russell even stated that he would like to see community gardening be a feature in the area's redevelopment.

All of these issues have been raised with Fawcett repeatedly, verbally and in writing, since neighborhood talks started in 2011, so none of this is a surprise. Regarding our latest petition effort, we sent a certified letter to Fawcett several weeks ago letting him know that there is still tremendous interest in preserving the Garden. We've heard no formal response, but we would be overjoyed to learn that he understands our point of view and sees the benefit to the neighborhood, which will include his family's rental properties and thus future tenants. We hope that he agrees to resume the sale with renewed focus and vigor.

But as a hedge against that, and in case it just can't be done amicably, we need a strong statement from the City that this site is valuable and must be preserved, and the willingness to use eminent domain is exactly that.

Save the Whittemore Community Garden

A natural refuge in an urban environment

When commercial greenhouse owner Ed Norberg no longer needed the land, he let the public use it as a community garden. For over 30 years, residents had space to grow flowers and food and to connect with nature. Pockets of open space amidst development are important for our health and the environment. Tilled gardens are better at storing water than compacted soil, and this site is in the Alewife Brook floodplain.

More than just a garden: A Community Garden

The garden was also a place for neighbors to meet. Located just off Mass Ave, near the T, and along Linear Park, residents from across the City would garden here and chat with each other and passers-by. As residential projects like Fawcett Oil's are built and we welcome hundreds of new neighbors, spaces like these become even more vital to building community. This garden had 65 plots, 15% of the City's total, with room for more. Restoring the Garden would reduce the 2-year wait for people seeking plots City-wide.

The City Council already voted to buy it in 2011

At that time Fawcett was amenable to a sale. An appraisal was completed and a price determined. Soil testing was performed, and a moderate amount of arsenic was found. Since then, the contaminated soil has been removed, but Fawcett hasn't renewed discussions with the City, and he has filed a subdivision plan.

A special place in a neighborhood being transformed

3.8 acres of Fawcett Oil land are in the process of being developed, replacing industrial uses with residential ones. 75 new units of housing are being created along Linear Park, with 57 in one building. With the grand scale of these changes, how can there not be room to preserve such a unique and special resource?

Let's make sure everyone knows how important this is

It's time to remind Mr. Fawcett that we, and his future tenants, want the land sold to the City so the Garden can be restored. It's time to remind the City that we still want this. And unlike our 2011 petition, this time we're asking that the City force the sale (via "eminent domain") if negotiations continue to stall.
