Action for Boston Community Development, Inc. (ABCD) was incorporated in 1962 with major financial backing from the Ford Foundation. In 1964 it was designated Boston's official antipoverty agency. Since that time, ABCD has become the largest nonprofit human service agency in New England, serving over 100,000 low-income individuals and families annually, and reaching into a broad spectrum of neighborhoods in Greater Boston, including the city of Cambridge. Many of our federation members serve people statewide, offering Cambridge residents support groups for those HIV/AIDS or mental illness, programs for Native Americans, and programs organizing individuals to combat homelessness. ABCD's programs include Headstart, Fuel Assistance, Foster Grandparents, and the Citywide Hispanic Center.
