How to get to **fresh pond day**

bus From Harvard Square T Station #72 gets you to the corner of Huron Ave and Fresh Pond Pkwy. #74 and #78 gets you to the Sunoco station on Concord Ave. Cross into the Reservation and go left.

subway From Alewife T Station on the Red Line, turn right at Alewife Brook Parkway. Walk over the bridge, past the shopping centers, and cross Concord Ave at the Shell station. Enter at Lusitania Meadow. Follow the paved path, go left at the Perimeter Path.

bicycle From Harvard Square take Brattle Street and go right at Lakeview. Cross Fresh Pond Pkwy and go left.

car Parking is very limited at Fresh Pond. You may park at the Tobin School parking lot at 197 Vassal Lane, cross Fresh Pond Parkway, and turn left.



