I was unable to attend the Ordinance Committee meeting this past Wednesday evening but would still like to voice my support for carsharing services (such as Zipcar) in Cambridge.

I do not own a car and generally use public transport or walk to get around the city. However, having access to Zipcar has proved invaluable for me in accessing destinations outside the bounds of public transport - to attend a wedding, for example, in Harvard, MA, or a high school reunion in Groton, MA. Similarly, I use Zipcar for short trips locally when I need to transport a large amount of stuff - be it picking up wood for a woodworking class at the Cambridge Center for Adult Education, or going to Home Depot to get plants for my community garden plot and a blind for my apartment. I hope that carsharing is allowed to continue in Cambridge - it has improved my quality of life here in the city and I think that it has done so in a way that is as environmentally friendly as possible, encouraging and enabling low-use drivers such as myself to share cars.
