Staff at CASPAR's Emergency Service Center reach out to guests to encourage their participation in ACCESS, a program for guests in early recovery from substance abuse. Through ACCESS guests experience their sobriety in a mutually supportive, client-centered environment.

ACCESS participants benefit from sleeping quarters that are separate from the larger shelter population, privileges that include a guaranteed bed for the duration of the program, and use of the conference room, its television and VCR, as well as daytime off-site individual and group counseling and case management.

Guests are referred from ACCESS to further treatment, transitional housing programs with supportive services, vocational training programs, and/or sober living situations in the community. ACCESS serves as a short-term individualized springboard towards a healthier lifestyle and long-term sobriety.

PROGRAM SUMMARY

Healthy Homes Program's goals are to reduce the incidence of childhood asthma episodes, to improve the delivery of clinical services for pediatric asthma patients, and to improve home safety. Living conditions are improved by inspecting homes to identify asthma triggers and other safety hazards, providing advice on removing hazards from the home, and through advocacy with landlords. A vacuum with a special filter is available through our loan- out program to help clean away dust mites, lead, pollen and other particles. Services are delivered through home visits, community education, and case management activities.

There are two components of the Healthy Homes Program:

1. Healthy Homes Visits

Free assessments of homes to identify a wide range of safety concerns including asthma triggers, lead paints, safety hazards and code violations. For eligibility, a child must be under the age of 6. Families are usually referred by the State Department of Public Health, but can be referred by other means. The area served includes 25 communities immediately north and west of Boston.

2. Cambridge-Somerville Healthy Homes Program (Everett now included):

- Asthma interventions,
- eligibility: 12 years and under
- Diagnosed with asthma or Reactive Airways Disease (RAD)
- Live in Cambridge, Somerville, or Everett

Asthma Services include:

- Home assessment
- Assessment of the child by our asthma nurse
- Creation of an education and care plan for the child working with the child's primary care provider, school health nurse, and others to coordinate care
- Providing mattress and pillow covers to reduce exposure to dust mites
- Providing outlet covers, smoke detectors or batteries, and roach traps as needed
- Coordinating services to rid the home of pests and other code violations
- Professional house cleaning in limited cases
- Providing asthma and medical supplies in limited cases
- Special filtered vacuum loan-out program
