From Thursday, September 10, 2015, through Tuesday, September 15, 2015, the City conducted a non-binding vote for the renaming of Area IV. Residents had the opportunity to vote via SMS (text messaging) or online for the duration of the time period, or in-person on Saturday, September 12, 2015, at the Area IV Pride Day. Staff reached out to the Fletcher-Maynard School, Margaret Fuller House, Area IV Coalition, Area IV Youth Center, and other interested community members to conduct publicity around the vote. The City produced flyers and door hangers that were distributed to the neighborhood by community members, and on September 14 and September 15 City staff distributed the remaining door hangers not circulated by the above organizations. Additionally, the City used social media and the website to promote the vote.

All survey methods contained two required questions:



- “Should we rename Area IV?”
- “Do you live in Area IV?”



Optional questions included:

- “What should the City rename Area IV to?” – presented only to participants voting “Yes” for the renaming of Area IV.
- “How old are you?”
- Would you like to be notified of the results via email or SMS?


A total of 713 completed surveys were received: 370 votes via SMS, 128 votes at the Area IV Pride Day, and 215 votes online. The charts on pages 2-5 show the aggregated results for all votes cast and for votes cast by participants that indicated that they lived in Area IV. The following table provides a brief summary of the key results.






Respondents Living in Area IV:
