Cambridge, MA— **“100 from Cambridge,”** the **Cambridge Open Studios Preview Exhibition,** runs from January 25 through March 12, 2010 in the CAC Gallery. This event will serve as a visual appetizer for the second city-wide **Cambridge Open Studios (COS),** taking place over three weekends in April and May 2010. Artist Receptions on Monday, February 1 and March 1 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. celebrate this citywide, community arts event. The exhibition showcases 100 works by visual and performing artists, participating in Open Studios, including paintings, jewelry, fiber arts, ceramics, film, mixed-media, literary works, and more that can be seen in the intimate setting of artist studios and common venues over the course of the three Cambridge Open Studio weekends this spring.

To be included in the exhibition, artists must register by the early deadline of December 31, 2009. Discounts apply for early registration. More about Cambridge Open Studios – April & May 2010

The second citywide Cambridge Open Studios (COS) takes place over three weekends in April and May 2010. Each weekend focuses on a different Cambridge neighborhood:

COS - North/West: April 24 & 25, 2010

includes neighborhoods from Alewife and Fresh Pond, down to Porter and Harvard

COS – East: May 8 & 9, 2010

includes Lechmere, Inman and Kendall Square

COS – Central: May 22 & 23, 2010

includes Central Square, Mid Cambridge, Area IV and Cambridgeport

CAC Gallery is located in the Cambridge City Hall Annex at 344 Broadway, at the corner of Broadway and Inman Street. Metered parking is available on Inman Street and Broadway.

Directions via MBTA: Take the MBTA Red Line to Central Square. At street level proceed west on Massachusetts Avenue (towards Harvard Square) to Inman Street. Turn right and proceed north for four blocks to Broadway. Turn left and walk one block to Inman Street.
