ABOUT THE CAMP

The Cambridgeport Community School Summer Camp Experience provides an environment that is safe, friendly, and fun for the summer. The camp curriculum will consist of seven separate themes this summer. The themes are "All American Week," Story Book/ Superhero Characters, "Let's Build It Week", Medieval Marvels & Pirates, Animals, Sports/Olympics, and ending with Variety Week.

AGES

The camp serves children who will be entering the 1st grade up to children entering the 5th grade. Children will be grouped by age to allow them to participate in age appropriate activities.

HOURS AND DATES

Camp Hours are 8:00 am—3:30 pm or 8:00 a.m. - 5:30 p.m.

Monday—Friday, Starting Monday, July 2nd (Camp is closed on July 4th) and ending Friday, August 17th.

VISUAL & PERFORMING ARTS

Campers will have the opportunity to explore a variety of arts and crafts in the camp and at the ARTS IN THE PARK program located in Sennott Park. They will participate in performances by many local children entertainers and musicians from diverse cultural background.

Swimming Lessons, Floor Hockey, Basketball, Tee Ball, Scooter Sports, Soccer and other sport related activities will be incorporated.
