## Amendment of Honesty

*“We the People honor and respect our Indigenous People of the Western Hemisphere as the Mothers and Fathers of the Land.*

*Whereby: We the People recognize Native American Indians as the Ancestors, first Agriculturists and first Veterans of the Americas”*

Native Americans of Massachusetts, and the United States in particular, as well as the Western Hemisphere in general, have suffered humiliations ranging from evictions of their ancestral farms and family lands, forced education in Western thoughts, elimination of identities and outrageous genocide by past Europeans, to confinement in the case of Massachusetts and the United States to reservations which given the high levels of alcoholism, drug abuse, high unemployment, a negative casino-identity became killing fields for the dreams of many Native Americans who, historically, were self-sufficient stewards of the air and earth as Agriculturists, Artists, Musicians and Builders.

Our Native Peoples were not deserving of such cruel and inhumane treatment that was accorded them by the Spaniards, Puritans, British and the White Supremacy of North and South American Europeans with their Religious orders and violent, possessive ways.

Therefore, we seek an honest proclamation from YOU and ALL to create the best and brightest and most truthful positive identity that our Root People aka Mothers and Fathers of the Land would be pleased in seeing! **Is that asking for too much?** Please be honorable and if you cannot be honorable than please do us a favor and leave your office.

**PROCLAMATION BY  
“SUNSHINE OF THE AMERICAS FOUNDATION”  
FOR  
“THE WESTERN HEMISPHERICAL HOLIDAY”**

**An invitation to all Leaderships in social and political governments to proclaim this Hemispherical Holiday to all, especially to our Native American Indian Nation States.**

**Proclamation**

WHEREAS: Native Americans of Massachusetts and the United States in particular as well as the Western Hemisphere in general have suffered humiliations ranging from evictions of their ancestral lands, forced education in Western thought, elimination of identity and outrageous genocide, to confinement in the case of Massachusetts and the United States to reservations which given the high levels of alcoholism, drug abuse, high unemployment, negative casino-identity became killing fields for the dreams of many Native Americans who, historically, were self-sufficient stewards of the air and earth as Agriculturists, Artists, Musicians and Builders; and

WHEREAS: Native Peoples in the United States in particular and the Western Hemisphere in general have been alienated from their ancestral and social resources that were and are a way of life; and

WHEREAS:: The Massachusetts Bay Colony was the forerunner to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and, by such certain crimes against our Native Peoples were sadly committed against our Root Peoples in the name of the Royalty of England, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and in the name of religion; and

WHEREAS: Our Native Peoples were not deserving of such cruel and inhumane treatment that was accorded them by the Pilgrims, Puritans and the White Supremacy of North and South American Europeans with their Religious orders and ways; and

WHEREAS: There is still a torturous, intimidating representation of subjugation that still exists by the symbol that is currently on the Massachusetts state seal and flag which is a figure of an Indian beneath the sword and arm of a known murderer, Myles Standish; furthermore his arm and sword is in a position known in the “art of fencing” as the “cutting position”. The seal and flags are an evil symbol of genocide that took the lives of so many Natives that the history book records that the War of King Philip was the bloodiest of all United States domestic wars. Not long after the intense genocide and religious persecution of our Mothers and Fathers of the Lands an official seal for Massachusetts was created in the image of genocide and white supremacy in 1780 and this still stands today; and

WHEREAS: In later times an article entitled, “The Coat of Arms and Great Seal of Massachusetts” by E.H. Garrett in New England Magazine in September 1900 - February, 1901, it was written, that Professor Putnam of the Peabody Museum who was commissioned to have an updated drawing made for the state seal openly wrote and referred to Indians with the racist attribution as “savages”; and

WHEREAS: In 1898, Massachusetts Secretary of State William Olin who oversaw the commissioning of the new state seal “had decided to use for the crest the weapon that was the sword of Myles Standish. Myles Standish was the Pilgrim’s military leader of whom it is written in the history books “was best known for his proclivity for preemptive actions and vulgarity which resulted in at least two attacks on different groups of Native Americans the Nemasket raid and the Wessagusset massacre; and

WHEREAS: This state symbol has not been changed since the days that racist trajectory against our Native Peoples were allowed to unfortunately evolve into the Massachusetts state flag; and

WHEREAS: Our Native Peoples were the first Veterans to die for civil rights; and the first Agriculturalists of the land that currently includes the two Americas: both North and South America; and

WHEREAS: The traditional celebrations of Thanksgiving in the United States is neither a day of celebration or thanksgiving for our Native Peoples, but rather it is a day of mourning and gloom; and

WHEREAS: many of the foods that we lavishly enjoy today such as all potatoes, all tomatoes, tomato sauces, salsas, all corns, all peppers, all squashes and even cocoa and chocolate were foods that were “gifts” from the Native Peoples to the oppressive White Europeans of North and South Americas; and

WHEREAS: The year, the day and hour is long past when these contributions by our Native Peoples identity are NO LONGER APPRECIATED by the governments of the United States and the governments of all Nation States that comprise the Western Hemisphere; and

WHEREAS: The Sunshine of the Americas Foundation that is working with individual Tribal Governments and all National Americans has declared a Western Hemispherical Holiday in honor of our Native Peoples to be a celebration shortly after the Summer Solstice, yes it is a holiday that is on the full weekend after the Summer Solstices; and

WHEREAS: This Hemispherical Holiday will not be about mourning the past but rather celebrating the great and historic achievements of our Native American Brothers and Sisters as the Mothers and Fathers of the Land; as the first Agriculturists and First Veterans of the body politic of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, the United States in particular, and the Western Hemisphere in general; and

WHEREAS: During those times, educational communications will be highlighting the contributions of Native Americans in agriculture, the arts, medicine and philosophy will be broadcast throughout the Western Hemisphere; and

WHEREAS: By means of honoring our Native Peoples with this holiday weekend, we, here in Massachusetts and on behalf of the people of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts wish to express our deepest appreciation for all contributions by our Local Indigenous Nations resident in Massachusetts and their beloved Cousins and their respected Tribal Governments throughout the Hemisphere; as well as our sincerest apologies for all crimes that were committed either by omission or commission towards them as a people within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and beyond; and

WHEREAS: Within that vein, sitting as a Peoples representative, I, “place your name here”----- of the People of the 'State your location'----- wish to add a strong voice and a heavy heart by proclaiming honor to our Root Peoples and condemning the existing genocidal Massachusetts state flag and formally call all Peoples of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to formally condemn the state flag because of the racist import and trajectory that was inculcated into its design, namely the negative attribution of our Native American Brothers and Sisters; and

WHEREAS: As an elected representative of State, City or Town of the People of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, I, -----, heartily embrace the Western Hemispherical Holiday for our Native Americans that has been declared by the Sunshine of the Americas Foundation for this coming June 23<sup>rd</sup> to June 24<sup>th</sup> as a means of atoning for any crimes that were committed against our Native Peoples in the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts since the beginning of the Commonwealth and continuing to the present day;

Now Therefore Be it RESOLVED, that this State, City or Town Leadership proclaims to all in assembly and hereby honors and respects our Indigenous People of the Western Hemisphere as the Mothers and Fathers of the Land, and we formally recognize Native American Indians as the first Agriculturalists and the first Veterans of the Americas; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED ....

That we urge all the citizens of Massachusetts, all Citizens of New England, all Citizens of the United States and even all Citizens of this great Western Hemisphere to take cognizance of these contributions that our Native American Brothers and Sisters have imported in the spiritual, political, social and agricultural fields of the body politic of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, any U.S. State and any Nation in our Western Hemisphere to take part in activities honoring them as a People during all future times and celebrations of this great feast and memorial toward the Mothers and the Fathers of these Lands which we value and deeply love, as the Americas.

Please proclaim the aforementioned with spirit and joy, let us all be fair and honorable to our Root Peoples, the Mothers and Fathers of the Land. The reason why we are pointing at the negative genocidal past and comparing that to them as First Agriculturists is to promote truth and honor to our Native Indigenous. By so doing, we will raise their self esteem and create a better civilization for our Children and for future generations to see and love. By so recognizing them as First Agriculturists we create a clear and concise image that is respectful for all time. Join in the joy of honoring and finally getting the job completed on this most important matter.
