Minutes of the Cambridge Election Commissioners meeting Tuesday, December 8, 2009

The meeting of the Cambridge Election Commission was called to order by Commissioner King at 8:40 PM Tuesday, December 8, 2009 at the Cambridge Senior Center, 806 Mass. Av. Commissioners Bonislawski, Cobb and Sheinfeld were present. Executive Director Marsha Weirnerman, Karen Francis, Lesley Waxman and Ginnie Kelly from the Commission Staff were on hand. George Goverman, Election Auditor; Donald Drisdell, City Solicitor; Nancy Glowa, Deputy City Solicitor; Ini Thomei from the City Manager's office along with Robert Winters, Cambridge Civic Journal and Cambridge Chronicle intern Gila Babich were also present.

Five overseas ballots were then considered by the board. Commissioner Bonislawski then moved to accept them. Commissioner King seconded the motion which passed 4-0. The w/p and tally of the ballots was:

1 ballot in each of the following five precincts. One ballot in 6-2, 7-1 and 8-1 for Alan Kazei
One ballot in 5-1, and 6-3 for Michael Capuano

These ballots were to be added to the ballot totals.

After board review of seven provisional ballots received from seven precincts, there was a motion by Commissioner Sheinfeld to accept the 2 ballots from 5-2 and 9-3 and reject the 5 from 6-2, 7-3, 8-3, and the two from 10-2. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bonislawski and passed 4-0.

By consensus, the board accepted the results of the primary.

The Commission meeting adjourned at 10:20 PM.
