Proposed route: (New movements in italics)

Outbound from North Station: Starting from Leverett Circle in Boston, cross Museum of Science Bridge on Monsignor O'Brien Highway, *right on Museum way, left on North Point Boulevard, left on East Street, right on Cambridge Street*, left on First Street, right on Binney Street, continue on Galileo Galilei Way, left on Broadway, right into Main Street westbound turnaround at Cambridge Marriott Hotel, continue on Main St. westbound, right into Technology Square driveway, left on Broadway at Hampshire Street, left on Windsor Street, right on Massachusetts Avenue, left on Sidney Street, right on Erie Street, layover on Erie Street between Waverley and Sidney Streets.

Inbound to North Station: From above layover point, proceed west on Erie Street, right on Brookline Street, right on Pacific Street, left on Sidney Street, right on Green Street, left on Landsdowne Street, right on Massachusetts Avenue, left on Windsor Street. right on Broadway, right into Main Street westbound at Cambridge Marriott Hotel, right on Ames Street/Mid-Block Connector, left on Broadway, right on Galileo Galilei Way, continue on Binney Street, left on First Street, right on Cambridge Street, *left on East Street, right on North Point Boulevard, right on Museum Way, left on Monsignor O'Brien Highway*, cross Museum of Science Bridge to Leverett Circle, Boston.

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The Traffic, Parking and Transportation (TP&T) Department has reviewed a request for a routing change for the EZ Ride Shuttle. Attached is the EZ Ride Shuttle Routing with the revisions shown in italics. The new routing will enable the shuttle to serve employees and residents in the North Point area of Cambridge.

Our Department supports the routing change and recommends approval by the License Commission. Operation of EZ Ride Shuttle on the revised routing may commence when the access road under the Gilmore Bridge is open.

The EZ Ride Shuttle continues to provide an excellent transportation alternative for regional commuters and residents, helping to alleviate traffic congestion and air pollution in Cambridge. We strongly support the continued operation of this service.
