Why Turn-in Unused Prescriptions?

***Children and animals could be harmed if they find and swallow drugs.**

***Drugs can be scavenged and sold illegally.**

***Unused pharmaceuticals are environmental toxins; flushing them down the toilet can release them into our drinking water and soil.**
