**Scholarships:** A limited amount of money is available to provide partial scholarship for families who qualify. You may request a confidential financial aid form from the director. The deadline for turning in your forms is Thursday April 12, 2012. Income verification will be required please provide a copy of recent W2's or your last 4 paystubs.

**REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:** Registration is held on Tuesday, April 10, 2012 through Thursday April 12, 2012. Registration for all programs will be on a first-come, first-served basis in the Community School Office @ Peabody School. **Full payment** is required when you register.

**NOTE: There will be a \$20.00 registration fee per child for the school year.**

*Registration will not be held on Monday April 23rd (1<sup>st</sup> day of classes).*

**PAYMENTS:** Full payment is due at the time of registration unless a payment plan is arranged with the director. Checks should be made payable to: **Fitzgerald Community School.**

**\*Returned checks will be charged an additional \$25.00. Full payment must be received within 48 hours to avoid disrupting your child's program schedule.**

***If you have any outstanding balances due with any Department of Human Service Program your child may not register until all payments are up to date.***

**REFUNDS:** If a class does not fill, the class may have to be cancelled. This is a rare occurrence, but if it should happen you will be notified and given a full refund, with the opportunity to enroll in another class. We understand that there may be times when a class is not what your child expected. Refunds will be given only if we are notified within 24 hours of the first class your child attended. Exceptions for medical issues, documentation required.

**SCHOLARSHIPS:** A limited amount of money is available to provide partial scholarship for families who qualify. You may request a confidential financial aid form from the director. The deadline for turning in your forms is Thursday April 12, 2012. Income verification will be required please provide a copy of recent W2's or your last 4 consecutive paystubs.

**EARLY RELEASE DAYS:** Regular scheduled classes are not held on early release days. A special activity or field trip will be planned. Watch for flyers the week before, they will be distributed to all students. Class fees are set on the number of times a class actually meets. Therefore early release days and holidays, when there are no scheduled classes, have been taken into account and fees have been set accordingly.

**HOLIDAYS AND SNOW DAYS:** Classes are not held on snow days, school holidays or any other days there is no school for the Cambridge Public Schools.

**SPRING SESSION:** Classes have been scheduled to begin the week of Monday April 23, 2012 and end the week of Friday June 15, 2012.

**LATE FEE POLICY:** All children must be promptly picked up at the end of class. A \$1.00 late fee is assessed for a late pick-up for every minute or any fraction thereof starting 5 minutes after the class ends. Late fees must be paid within 48 hours of the week.


