Sun! Splash! Camp

Sun! Splash! Camp is operated by the Harrington Neighborhood Council and Department of Human Service Program, Community Schools Division. Our camp is an inclusive program offering educational and recreational activities in a safe nurturing and fun filled environment. Campers choose from a daily menu of activities designed to develop and support the individual child's interests and personal growth.

Age Ranges: Entering Jr. Kindergarten —6th Grade

Campers must be entering Kindergarten by September 2012
Children are grouped by age for all onsite activities.

Staff/Counselors

Our staff consist of a diverse group of talented artist, athletes and child care specialists with knowledge in literacy, science, art, drama, and sports . Many of our counselors are currently teaching in the Afterschool Enrichment Program. Mayor's Summer Youth Employment interns assist the counselors. Our staff ratio to child ensures that your child will receive the individual attention they need. All staff are trained in both First Aid and CPR. The Camp Director, Crisálida Rebelo, is on-site to lead the staff and to address parents' questions and concerns.

On Site Activities

Sun! Splash! Camp offers a project-based curriculum with specific themes such as Circus Adventures, Under the Sea, World Sports. Dance, theatre, art, music, literacy, sports and games complement our daily activities.

Special Activities

As a city camp, we explore our own backyard and the rich cultural resources of Cambridge and Eastern Massachusetts. Offsite field trips include visits to Museums, New England Aquarium, Fenway Park Tour, Cambridge Public Library, Castle Island, Roller World, and weekly beach trips. Parents are invited to an end of camp Pot Luck and camper's performance. They are also welcome to visit the camp and attend weekly beach trips.

Swimming

Campers enjoy weekly swim lessons, and opportunities for free swim at the Gold Star Pool. The aquatic staff are certified water safety instructors and lifeguards.

Meal and Snacks

Breakfast and afternoon snack are provided. Campers must bring a lunch each day. Any specialized diet must be provided by parents/guardians.

Dates of operation

The program starts on Monday, June 25, and runs for eight weeks through Friday, August 17, 2012. (*Camp closed Wednesday, July 4*)

Extended Day Hours

Supervised extended day is available
Monday through Friday 3:30—6:00 p.m.
Camp will close at 3:30 on Friday, August 17

Registration

Registration begins Monday, March 12. Applications are accepted on a first come first served basis. Registration takes place at the Community School office. Registration deadline is Friday, June 1.
\$20.00 non-refundable application fee is due at registration.

Cost per session

\$320.00 (8:00 a.m.—3:30 p.m.)
\$400.00 (8:00 a.m.—6:00 p.m.)

\$50.00 deposit is required for each session registered.

This deposit is applied towards the total tuition and is non-refundable after Friday, May 25. Payment is due one week prior to the start of each session. All payments must be made by check or money order to the Harrington Neighborhood Council.

Financial Assistance

Partial scholarship is available for income eligible families. Income verification is required. Applications for Financial Assistance must be received by Friday, May 18.
We accept Child Care Resource Center Vouchers.

Licensing

This camp is inspected annually to comply with the regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health. (105CMR 430.00) and is licensed annually by the Cambridge Board of Health.
