Dear Mr. Tumwine:

On Tuesday, February 11, 2014, the License Commission voted 3-0 to rescind its November 26, 2013 vote recommending approval of your application to the City Manager for the City Council. The reason for this action was because you applied for service at Alewife MBTA station for 7 days a week, but your Agreement with the MBTA only allows you to access their property on Saturday and Sunday.

The Commission then voted 3-0 to recommend approval of your original application for the City Manager to the City Council, amended by the Board of License Commissioners, for Saturday and Sunday service only, which are the days you have permission to be on the MBTA's Alewife property. This application will be heard by the City Council on February 24, 2014. You may attend this hearing if you would like to speak before the Council.

You must maintain the Saturday and Sunday schedule as well as the route that was submitted to the Board with the application. Any scheduling changes must be submitted in writing to the Board of License Commissioners. All route changes must be approved by the License Commission and the City Council.



## MEMORANDUM

**Re:** Diaspora Investment Associates d.b.a. Horizon bus line.

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Our Department received a jitney route request in 2013 from Diaspora Investment Associates doing business as Horizon bus line. Horizon bus line proposes to operate a passenger bus line service between Cambridge and New York with a stop in Cambridge at the Alewife MBTA station.

The proposed route is as follows:

**Inbound to Alewife Station:** Route 2 eastbound to Alewife Brook Parkway to Cambridgepark Drive to Alewife MBTA Station bus drop-off/pick up area within the station.

**Outbound to New York:** Exit Alewife MBTA station onto Cambridgepark Place northbound, to Alewife Access Road to Route 2 westbound.

Although Horizon bus line was originally seeking bus service seven days a week, they have obtained approval from the MBTA to pick up/drop off passengers at Alewife Station on Saturdays and Sundays only, from January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014.

The TP&T Department supports the jitney route for Horizon bus line with the following conditions:

- Horizon bus line must have approval from the MBTA to drop-off/pick-up passengers at Alewife Station. (They are currently approved Saturdays and Sundays only from January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014).
- If at any time the MBTA terminates the agreement with Diaspora, Horizon bus line must cease operating the route.
- This Department should approve any routing changes to the service.
- All loading and unloading must occur within the MBTA Alewife Station.
- No stopping on Cambridgepark Drive or Cambridgepark Place is permitted.
- No stopping in the travel lane or blocking through traffic.
- No illegal u-turns shall be done. Changing of directions should be conducted as indicated on the routing plan.

1. Use and Occupancy Agreement

The Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority, a body politic and corporate and a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, established and existing pursuant to Chapter 161A of the Massachusetts General Laws, with a usual place of business at 10 Park Plaza, Boston, Massachusetts (hereinafter referred to as "MBTA"), hereby grants to Diaspora Investment Association, Inc., 24 Crescent Street, ste 307, Waltham, Massachusetts ("OCCUPANT") the right and privilege to enter upon, use and occupy a portion of certain property of the MBTA identified as the pick up/drop off areas, at Alewife Station in Cambridge, Massachusetts and Riverside Station, in Newton, Massachusetts as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto, and incorporated herein, (hereinafter referred to as the "Premises") for the purposes described in the Scope of Use and Occupancy below and elsewhere in this agreement (the "Agreement"). Such use and occupancy may be conducted only during the Term.

2. General Conditions

- 2.1 Date: November 20, 2013
- 2.2 OCCUPANT: Diaspora Investment Association, Inc.
- 2.3 Term: <sup>January</sup> December 1, 2013 <sup>December</sup> to November 30, 2014, <sup>4 CB</sup> SATURDAYS AND SUNDAYS ONLY; except that the MBTA may terminate this Agreement at any time with thirty (30) days written notice.
- 2.4 Occupancy Fee: \$1,000.00 per month payable in advance on the first day of each month, without demand, based on an annual fee of \$12,000.00. In addition to the OCCUPANCY Fee, OCCUPANT shall pay to the MBTA an additional fee in the amount of Seven Dollars (\$7.00) for each bus *departing* from the Premises under this Agreement. Such payment shall be paid in arrears on the 1st day of each month commencing on January 1, 2014 (payment for December 2013) together with the OCCUPANCY Fee payment. At the time of such payment, OCCUPANT shall submit to Transit Realty Associates ("TRA"), Accounting Dept., 77 Franklin Street, 9<sup>th</sup> floor, Boston, Massachusetts 02110, a statement of the number of bus departures for the previous month.
- 2.5 Administrative Fee: \$ 1,000.00- Paid
- 2.6 Premises: A portion of the MBTA Alewife Station Busway in Cambridge, Massachusetts and a portion of the Riverside Station Busway in Newton, Massachusetts for the discharge and pick-up of OCCUPANT's passengers.

4. Street Use: Grove Street

5. Passenger Pickup: The Riverside MBTA Station

6. Modifications: Subsequent to the renewal of the License, the Licensee shall be authorized to make minor adjustments to the regular bus service. The Licensee shall notify the Chief of Police



within five (5) business days of any adjustment in the days of operation and hours. The Chief of Police shall maintain a file of all such requests in order to verify the total changes to the service at the end of each License term. Any other changes to the regular service shall require the approval of the Board of Aldermen. The license is valid only for the licensee stated herein and shall not be transferred or otherwise assigned without the prior written approval of the Board of Aldermen.

7. Term: This License is valid beginning May 30, 2013 and shall expire on May 30, 2016. Subsequent license renewals shall be granted in the discretion of the Board of Aldermen.

8. Enforcement and violation: The Chief of Police shall be charged with the enforcement of the provisions of this License. Violation of any of the above provisions shall be cause for revocation of this license in accordance with procedures to be established by the Board of Aldermen.

9. Hold harmless: Deo Dumwine/Diaspora Investment Association Inc. d/b/a/ Horizon Bus Line systems, and their officials, trustees, agents, servants and employees shall hold harmless and defend the City of Newton from and against all claims, damages, demands and actions of every kind arising out of the exercise of this License.

10. Severable provisions: The provisions of this License are severable. If any of the provisions of this License are held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this License shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect, provided that upon such a finding or invalidity the City shall have the right to initiate proceedings to revise the remaining provisions of the License in a manner not inconsistent with any such finding of invalidity.




