We the undersigned residents of Cambridgeport and neighbors and/or residents of Lawrence and Corporal McTernan Streets SUPPORT A DANA PARK AREA HUBWAY STATION AND CYCLING AS A FORM OF TRANSPORTATION BUT OPPOSE either Lawrence Street or McTernan Street as permanent locations for the Dana Park Hubway station.

Among the reasons are:

1. Public Safety

- a. The mounting and dismounting of Hubway bikes on densely populated one way residential streets increases the chances of collisions and accidents.**
- b. Cyclists, including Hubway riders, often ride the wrong way on the one way streets increasing the chances of accidents.**
- c. Cyclists, including Hubway riders, are not always wearing helmets increasing the risk of accidents.**

2. Congestion:

- a. Hubway Trucks frequently loading and unloading bikes can block other vehicles creating more traffic delays and congestion.**
- b. A permanent station combined with the daily Hubway truck deliveries would make other vehicle deliveries to residents for home repair vehicles, fuel, postal, groceries, trash pickup and recycling more problematic.**

3. Parking:

- a. A permanent station would eliminate 50 feet (3 parking spaces) of parking for residents.**
- b. Last winter's record snowfall made parking even more**

restricted on Cambridge's residential streets and a permanent station would make a bad situation even worse.

4. Public Transportation/Commercial Activity

a. Residential one way streets are not the optimum location for a permanent public transportation hub and the commercial activity it entails including marketing, billboards and credit card processing that Hubway requires.
