Re: Awaiting Order 14-136, Resident Parking at Kendall Square Garage during Snow Emergencies

This memo is a response to Awaiting Order 14-136 regarding whether resident parking during snow emergencies will still be allowed at the parking garage adjacent to the Kendall Square Movie Theater. As noted in the Council Order, this garage has been sold to a new owner since last winter.

Staff from Traffic, Parking & Transportation (TP&T) spoke with Mike Fitzgerald who represents the new owner DivcoWest. He informed us that, pursuant to our inquiry, the new owner has agreed to provide no cost parking at the One Kendall Square Garage to Cambridge residents who have City resident parking permits on their vehicles during snow emergencies. This free parking will be available from the time the City's declared snow emergency is in effect until two hours after it is lifted. The garage entrance is at 389 Binney Street, next to the Kendall Square Cinema.

The new owner has also agreed that the City should provide this information in the TP&T section of the City's website, where similar arrangements at other garages are listed, so that more residents will be aware of this opportunity. The information has already been added to the Winter Parking section under the Parking tab of department's website, www.cambridgema.gov/traffic.
