


The reconstruction of Massachusetts Avenue from Memorial Drive to Main Street enhances the safety and convenience for all users of the roadway with the installation of new sidewalks and pedestrian crossings, bicycle lanes, street trees, decorative lighting and a new park at Lafayette Square. The new park, with significant plantings, public art, and decorative granite work, creates a sense of place at this historic crossroads.

This park is being dedicated in memory of Jill Brown-Rhone, a Cambridge police officer who was born and grew up in the neighborhood.
