Please use the Walker Street entrance of the Graham & Parks School. Dropped off registrations will be accepted daily beginning on Tuesday, September 14th between 2:30-6:00pm. Otherwise, completed forms may be left in the Community School mailbox in the Graham & Parks main office. Classes begin the following week. Please enclose a check payable to "Community School", one check for total amounts per family. Your check is your receipt. If a class is full, you will be notified. If you are not notified, assume that your child is enrolled. These classes fill very quickly, so early registration is advised.

- Special Activities will be offered on Early Release days from 12:30-3:15 - during program sessions. Fee: \$7.00. Please register in advance.
- No refunds after the first week.
- Children must remain in the Community School Center while waiting for classes.
