REGISTRATION PROCEDURES:

Registration begins when you receive this brochure. Register early since many classes fill quickly. Registration forms may be dropped off in the Community School mailbox in the Graham & Parks School main office or handed to a member of the Community School staff. Please enclose a check made payable to "Community Schools"; one check for total amount per family. Your check is your receipt. If a class is full, you will be notified. If you are not notified, assume that your child is enrolled. Returned check fee is \$25.00 and must be paid within 48 hrs. Please note, there is a \$20.00 academic year registration fee per child to help defray administrative costs.

- Special Activities will be offered on Early Release days from 12:30-3:15, followed by the regular Enrichment schedule - Fee \$20.00 per day. Registration must be received in advance.
- All G & P children must be registered for the Afterschool Activities Club 2:25-3:15 on the day that they are enrolled in an Enrichment Class. Otherwise, parents may choose to wait with their child or take them home and bring them back for classes.
- Students who arrive from other schools are welcome to purchase snack for \$1 per day.
- Refunds are granted for documented medical issues. If the issues are not medical, no refunds will be given after the first week; however, your child may select a different class.
- We are only responsible for children during class time. They must wait in the Community School Center. Please inform us if someone other than a parent will be picking up your child.
- Piano slots are saved from the Fall Term.
- Partial scholarships available - you may request a Financial Aid Application. All information submitted is kept confidential. Please consider contributing to our Neighborhood Council Scholarship Drive.
- Fees for late pick-up of your child will be charged at the rate of \$10.00 for every 15 minute increment or fraction of and must be paid within 48 hours.
- Classes are not held when Cambridge Public Schools are closed.
- Office hours daily 2:00-6:00 PM and Mondays & Thursdays until 7:00 PM
- Community School Programs are offered under the direction of the Linnaean Neighborhood Council. The Council holds bi-monthly meetings on Tuesdays at 6:00 p.m.; please call for dates.
