1) Laura Baring-Gould / Fresh Pond

The final concept modifies two existing water fountains (1. Maher Park and 2. the fountain on the perimeter trail closest to Little Fresh Pond) by replacing the existing basin components with bronze or stainless steel sculptural basins made in a low-relief technique.

Laura presented a Powerpoint with maps and visuals of Fresh Pond, the existing fountains, her previous artwork, and sketches of what the basins will like when created.

Rika asked Laura to consider in her design eliminating deep impressions where water would collect. Rika also asked her to work with the fountain company to engineer a way to incorporate four security screws. As for aging, Laura stated that she is ok with the bronze aging, therefore 'greening' over time.

The timeline is to fabricate over the fall and winter and install the fountains in May of 2012.
