Cambridge Police to Participate in Area IV Peace Walk and Community Pride Day on Saturday, September 11th

September 10, 2010 – The Second Annual Area IV Peace Walk will kick off Area IV Community Pride Day. Those participating will be gathering tomorrow, September 11th, at Sennott Park (at the corner of Broadway and Norfolk St.) at 11:00 AM and walking through the Area IV neighborhood in celebration of Pride Day's message of peace, community and positive change in our city.

The walk will end in Clement Morgan Park on Columbia St., just in time for the 8th Annual Area IV Community Pride Day. Pride Day will run from 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM at Clement Morgan Park (located between Columbia and Pine Streets, between Washington and Bishop Allen Streets).

Pride Day includes music and entertainment, free food, activities for children (including face painting, pony rides, and a "moon bounce," as well as a health fair and information from a range of community groups and organizations.

This event is being hosted by several city and community agencies, including the Cambridge Police Department, the Cambridge Department of Human Service Programs, and the Cambridge Health Alliance.
