Shot Fired at Cambridge Police Officer, Suspect Arrested

November 13, 2010 – At approximately 2:05 AM, Kai Robert Kruger, 21, of Grozier Road in Cambridge was arrested for the Armed Robbery of three individuals on Brattle Street as well as for Assault with Intent to Murder after firing a gun at a Cambridge Police Officer during a brief foot pursuit as a result of the robbery.

A Cambridge Police Officer was patrolling the area of Brattle Street when he came upon a group of four males, one of whom he observed acting suspiciously. When the officer stopped to investigate, one of the males, later identified as Kai Rober Kuger, fled across Brattle Street towards a construction site. The officer immediately gave chase on foot, and as he came around the fencing surrounding the construction site, he observed Mr. Kruger stop at the top of a set of stairs, turn towards him, and fire one shot at him.

The shot missed, and the officer drew his weapon in response to the threat posed by Mr. Kruger. As Mr. Kruger turned to flee, he fell down the stairs and the officer was immediately able to disarm him and take him into custody without incident.

Neither Mr. Kruger nor the officer involved was injured as a result of this incident.

The three other males originally seen with Mr. Kruger reported to police that they were robbed by the suspect prior to police arrival and were also unharmed.
