## Two New Officers Join Cambridge Police Department

Officer Brendan O’Hearn, 27, and Officer James “Matt” Brown, also 27, are both lateral transfers from the Watertown Police Department and officially began their service to the City of Cambridge this morning at 9:40 AM when they were sworn in by Deputy City Clerk Donna Lopez. Also in attendance at the ceremony were Commissioner Robert C. Haas and members of the Cambridge Police Department Command Staff.

Officer O’Hearn was a member of the Watertown Police Department for 4 ½ years where he served on the department’s Criminal Apprehension Team.

Officer Brown was a member of the Watertown Police Department for nearly 6 years and also served on the Criminal Apprehension Team. Brown was also a member of the Motorcycle Unit.

After their official swearing in, Commissioner Haas welcomed the new officers, saying, “We at the Cambridge Police Department as well as the citizens of Cambridge are lucky to have two more skilled additions to our police force. Welcome to you both, good luck, and thank you for your service.”
