Deputy Lester Sullivan Retires After 38 Years of Service



October 19, 2010 – On October 4, 2010, Deputy Lester Sullivan retired after serving the Cambridge Police Department, the City of Cambridge, and its citizens for 38 years.

He began his service in 1972 as a Cambridge Police Cadet, and through hard work and dedication, graduated to the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police.
