Authorities Investigating Suspicious Death

CAMBRIDGE – Authorities are investigating a suspicious death that occurred in Cambridge this afternoon, Middlesex District Attorney Gerry Leone and Cambridge Police Commissioner Robert Haas informed the public today.

According to authorities, EMS personnel responded early this afternoon to 77 Elm Street in Cambridge for a medical call. Upon arrival, they located a man who was transported to Cambridge City Hospital where he was pronounced dead. An autopsy will be conducted by the Office of the Medical Examiner to determine the cause and manner of death. The decedent's identification is being withheld pending notification of next of kin.

Gylene Verna, 29, of Cambridge, has been charged with domestic assault and battery in connection with the incident.

The investigation remains active and ongoing by Cambridge Police and the Massachusetts State Police assigned to the Middlesex District Attorney's Office. This appears to be an isolated familial domestic incident at this time.
