## Qualifications to Vote

Be a citizen of the United States and a resident of the State of Massachusetts

Be 18 years of age or older on or before Election Day –*See below*

Be a Cambridge resident to vote in the local Cambridge elections


## 2010 Election Dates

State Primary – September 14, 2010

- Last day to register – August 25, 2010

General/Presidential Election – November 2, 2010

- Last day to register – October 13, 2010



If you will be 18 years old on or before Election Day . . .

- Must register before August 25, 2010 to vote in both the September State Primary and the November General Election. Or, must register between September 15, 2010 and October 13, 2010 to vote in the General Election.

## What are the Cambridge Election Commission's office hours?
