Minutes of the Cambridge Election Commissioners meeting Tuesday, January 6, 2010

The meeting of the Cambridge Election Commission was called to order by Commissioner Bonislowski at 3:00 PM Wednesday, January 6, 2010 at the Cambridge Election Commission offices 51 Inman St., Cambridge. Commissioners Cobb, King and Sheinfeld were present. Executive Director Marsha Weinerman, Lesley Waxman and Nick Leon from the Commission Staff were on hand. Ethan Cobb was also present.

The Minutes of the Nov. 30th meeting were accepted as edited.

The minutes of the December 8th meeting were accepted as presented.

The Executive Director gave a report based on the attached agenda.

Commissioner Cobb moved to approve the list of Designated Health Care Facilities. The motion was seconded by Commissioner King and passed 4-0. The list of the approved facilities is item R4 in the attached Executive Director's report.

Commissioner Cobb moved to have the text surrounded by the border in item R-5 of the Executive Director's Report, added to the Voter Registration Request Form. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bonislowski and passed 4-0.

Commissioner King moved to authorize the Executive Director to dispose of the 3 groups of ballots specified in item C of her report. Commissioner Cobb seconded the motion and it passed 4-0.

Commissioner Cobb moved that the polling place location now at the Haggerty School be moved to the Sheila Russell West Cambridge Youth Center. Commissioner Bonislowski seconded it and it was passed 4-0.

Commissioner Bonislowski reported that 389 1/2 Columbia St. is a valid address. She also reported that 526 and 600 Cambridge St. were both not valid address for voter registration as they are store fronts.

Commissioner Sheinfeld reported that 76 Amory and 16 Ellery were both valid addresses for voter registration.

Commissioner Cobb reported that 132 Harvey St. is a valid address for voter registration.

The meeting adjourned at 4:25 PM.
