Using Play to Enhance Emotional and Behavioral Development for Children with Autism Spectrum Disorders



Come meet Dr. Karen Levine and Naomi Chedd, LMHC, specialists in autism and related developmental disabilities, and hear about their new book, *Replays*.

Replays is an easy and fun tool that addresses the challenging behaviors of children through interactive, symbolic play. Levine and Chedd have developed a technique that helps children to re-experience and master the complex emotional response states that often lead to ongoing behavioral challenges. They describe ways of implementing and adapting this intervention in different settings and circumstances.

Replays can be used by teachers, therapists and parents to guide children with autism spectrum disorders and related challenges toward changing their emotional and behavioral responses. With numerous examples and illustrations, the book leads readers step-by-step through this enjoyable and easy-to-learn intervention.
