Minutes of the Cambridge Election Commissioners meeting Tuesday, September 22, 2009

The regular meeting of the Cambridge Board of Election Commissioners was held at the Election Commission Office on Tuesday, September 22, 2009. The meeting was called to order at 4:00 PM by Commissioner Bonislawski. Commissioners, Cobb, King, Sheinfeld were also in attendance. Executive Director Marsha Weinerman, Karen Francis and Leslie Waxman from the Election Commission and were present. Ethan Cobb and Molly Byrne also attended.

The minutes of the September 15 meeting were approved by consensus.

The Executive Director gave a report based on the attached agenda. This report included extended discussions of ballot box scanner messages and changes to various parts of the Warden and Clerk training manual.

Executive Director Weinerman stressed that the poll worker training sessions will be Saturday, Oct 24th Noon to 1:00PM for Inspectors and 1:00PM to 3:30PM for Wardens and Clerks. Training sessions will also be held on Tuesday, Oct 27th for Inspectors from 6:00 PM to 7:00 PM and for Wardens and Clerks from 7:00 PM to 9:30 PM.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORTS

Commissioner Bonislawski reported that 61 Clark st. does not exist and is not a valid address for registration. She also indicated that 2 Cambridge Center is the Marriott Hotel and not a valid address for voter registration.

Commissioner King noted the recent Poll worker recruitment sessions which he chaired, were both well attended.

Commissioner Sheinfeld reported that 1464 Cambridge St. had been vacant for some time during apparently extensive renovation and was now a valid registration address and looked to be occupied. 185 River St is not a valid address. It would be in the middle of Howard St. where it intersects River St.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:50 PM.
