CAMBRIDGE HISTORICAL COMMISSION

Each year, the Cambridge Historical Commission honors projects that have made outstanding contributions to the preservation of the city's historic character and built environment. **The 2011-2012 awards will recognize individuals and/or organizations for projects completed between January and December 2011.** The 2012 awards ceremony will be on May 17, during National Preservation Month.

Seven project categories are eligible for Preservation Awards: **restoration, rehabilitation, adaptive reuse, neighborhood conservation, landscape preservation, archaeology, and preservation education.** The award-winning projects will be selected based on the following:

- ♦ historical and architectural significance of the preserved property;
- ♦ exceptional quality of the project;
- ♦ extent to which the project contributed to the preservation of the property;
and
- ♦ impact of the project on the preservation of the city's historic resources.

To nominate a project, *including your own*, please submit the completed nomination form (see reverse) and supporting documentation
no later than 12:00 PM (Noon) on Friday, February 17th, 2012.
