

## BIKE REPAIR STANDS IN CAMBRIDGE

Have you ever found yourself frustrated by a low tire, a loose chain, or a wiggly handlebar? Things that are readily fixed, but that need the proper tools, which never seem to be at hand when you need them. Now you can take advantage of the free, publicly available, bike repair stands installed in Cambridge. Just roll up your bike and find the right tool, whether it's an Allen wrench, a tire lever or an air pump. You can also lift the bike onto the stand for easier access (see photo below).



The stands are located here:

- \* **Fresh Pond Reservation** (photo, right), by the public entrance where the clock tower is
- \* **Harvard Square**, in the parking lot at the corner of Eliot and Brattle Streets underneath the Harvard Square Hotel
- \* **Cambridge Main Library**, along the path to the right of the entrance as you face the building
- \* **Kendall Square**, at the corner of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Broadway, in front of One Broadway, location of the Cambridge Innovation Center
