CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL & REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF CHARCOAL AND GAS FIRED GRILLS, GENERATORS, HEATERS, AND OTHER MISCELLANEOUS COOKING EQUIPMENT AT PUBLIC EVENTS

- 1) At no time will any grill, generator, heater, or other cooking equipment be left unattended when in use. The equipment shall at all times be under the personal supervision of the permit holder or another qualified person acting under his/her direction who shall remain at the location until the equipment is no longer being used.
- 2) No grill, generator, heater, or other cooking appliance shall be used on, at, or near any combustible material.
- 3) Public access to the cooking area and public access to any tents or canopies used in the cooking areas shall be prohibited.
- 4) At least one (1) fire extinguisher with a minimum 40BC rating shall be located at each cooking station. Charcoal grills shall have at least one (1) pressurized water extinguisher or charged garden hose nearby.
- 5) LP-gas cylinders being used shall be in compliance with the Board of Fire Prevention Regulations 527CMR 6:00 and NFPA Standard 58.
- 6) No storage of extra LP-gas cylinders is permitted on site unless approved by the fire official. Changing of LP-gas cylinders is prohibited.
- 7) No storage of extra gasoline for generators is permitted on site unless approved by the fire official.
- 8) LP-cylinders must be kept a minimum of five (5) feet from the cooking appliance.
- 9) Cooking appliances must be operated on a flat level surface.
- 10) Drip pans used under cooking appliances shall be non-combustible.
- 11) Wind blockers for cooking units shall be non-combustible.
- 12) Tents open to the public must be in compliance with 527CMR 19:00. Heaters are prohibited from use inside tents. Indirect heating shall be used.

Each cooking station will be inspected for compliance during the event. Any violations found must be corrected or the cooking station will not be allowed to operate.

The holder of this permit must abide by all rules and regulations of the Cambridge Fire Department which may be amended from time to time. Violation of any applicable law, regulations or any condition contained therein shall render this permit as void.
