General Program Information

Enrichment Program

Classes will begin on Monday January 9th and will run through Friday, April 13, 2012. The enrichment program begins at 1:55 with 30 minutes of outside play & snack. Classes begin at 2:30pm. On early release days classes will not meet but we will sponsor a field trip from 11:30-5:30. You may register your child on the enrollment sheet.

Registration Procedures

Registration will take place on Wednesday December 14th until day Friday December 16th at 9am. Simply drop off your **completed** registration form in our box located in the multipurpose room before 9am on Friday and our staff will do the rest! ***For students in grades 1-5 please list your alternative classes so that your child will have a slot during that time period.*** Enrollment will be selected at random & receipt of your child(ren)'s enrolled classes will be mailed to your home address by January 3, 2012.

Payment Procedures

Full payment is due when enrollment is confirmed; however, you can set up a monthly payment plan. Payments should be made by check or money order payable to the: **HAGGERTY COMMUNITY SCHOOL**. All City-Wide Outstanding Balances Must Be Paid in Full Prior to Registration! Your registration will not be accepted until full payment has been made. A returned check will be charged an additional \$25.00 to cover the banking fee. Full payment must be received within 48 hrs and payable by money order.

Financial Assistance

Limited financial assistance is available for income eligible families. Income verification is required. A copy of W2 forms from 2010 or four consecutive recent paystubs is required. All requests for scholarship must be received by Friday December 16, 2011. If you have already submitted scholarship information for the Fall the same percentage will be awarded for the Winter & Spring; unless, your financial situation shall change and you need to reapply.

Picking Up Your Child & Child's Absence

Please be mindful our instructors have taken time to prepare to have your children in their class during the hours listed. Please plan accordingly & pick up your child at the proper dismissal time. Instructors leave after their classes end and cannot be responsible for student supervision once their class is dismissed. Because students need to be picked up promptly, there will be a late fee of \$1 per minute after the class has ended.

Things happen, children become ill, appointments need to be kept and play dates may be arranged. **We simply ask if you can contact the program at 617.349.6264 or email us akierce@cambridgema.gov leaving a message that your child will be absent, someone else will be picking them up, or you are delayed.**

Cancellation & Refunds

Courses with insufficient enrollment will be cancelled, in which case a replacement course may be selected or a refund will be issued. Additional refunds will only be given before the

second-class meeting or in the event of a medical concern. Refunds will not be given if a child misses classes.
