The following questions were submitted and answered:

1. Will the fire alarm company be onsite to man the fire alarm panel during the fire sprinkler testing and inspections or should the fire sprinkler company provide an extra technician to man the fire alarm panel during the fire sprinkler testing and inspections?

The City's Electrical Department will accompany the fire sprinkler contractor during testing and inspections.

2. Is the fire sprinkler testing portion prevailing wage?

Yes, the contract requires prevailing wages.

3. Is there a scheduled walk through of the locations? Who can I contract to schedule a walk through of the locations?

There is no scheduled walk through for the buildings.

4. Are there any recent fire sprinkler test reports from the locations available?

Yes, the last scheduled inspections and testing was July 2014. We will make the test reports available to the contractor that is awarded the bid.


5. What was the last awarded contract bid price for this bid?
